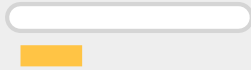
write descriptive links and headings

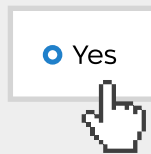
publish all information on web pages

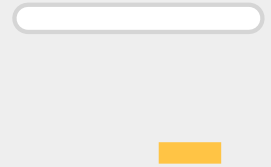
write uninformative links and headings
