

Masters of their domain: why men "reboot"

- NoFap: generic name for men abstaining from Pornography, Masturbation, Orgasm (PMO) cycle to "reboot" brains + gain "superpowers"
 - > r/NoFap, via NoFap LLC, 1.1 million users; r/PornFree, 350k, Reboot Nation approx. 24k numerous content creators/products
 - > Abstain from pornography (soft mode), pornography and masturbation (medium), or orgasms entirely (hard) for 90 days: a test of self-discipline
- Masturbation historically linked to adverse outcomes via institutions/public figures, e.g., degradation and mental/physical health (Hartmann, 2021)
 - > Reboot communities: less explicitly condemnatory utilise aspirational language of self-help (Johannsen, 2021; Smith et al., 2022)
 - > Sex drive = masculine; failure to yield control/self-governance = feminine lack of regulation (Taylor & Jackson, 2018)
- Argue pornography exploits adaptive masculine sex drive calibrated for novelty: dopamine systems cannot distinguish between stimulation achieved via "real" intercourse versus artificial "reel" alternative. Demotivating: cuts link between sexual labour/effort and reward (Hartman, 2021; Taylor & Jackson, 2018)
 - > Masturbating man: disengaged, passive; Post-masturbatory man: supposed benefits of self-ownership, e.g., testosterone, motivation, control, etc.
- 75% of members see misogynistic content + bullying (48%), anti-LGBT+ content (42%), antisemitism (32%), and threats (23%) (Prause & Binnie, 2023)
 - r/NoFap shares members/themes with manosphere spaces, e.g., Pick Up Artists sites + r/MRA, r/MGTOW, and r/Incel
 - > Sometimes included in manosphere literature reviews (Han & Yin, 2022; Johannsen, 2021; Prause & Ley, 2024)
- Abstinence linked to "natural" economy of masculine subjecthood and sexual success via three key manosphere discourses below:

Members in good standing? Crossover with the manosphere



A war against masculinity

Taking control of your sexuality and regaining masculinity is something I can talk about as a man. There's no point pretending this is an androgynous shared experience (r/NoFap user, Taylor & Jackson, 2018)

I want that power back. Real women, real life, real respect. It's out there for us (r/NoFap user, Taylor & Jackson, 2018)

- Pornography = tool to subvert natural patriarchal order: abstinence as defiance against nefarious forces, e.g., feminists, socialists, liberals etc. (Burnett, 2021; Johannsen, 2021)
- Sissyhypno conspiracy: subtypes feminise men by subverting trad scripts (Johannsen, 2021)
- Men must reconnect with the vilified, natural masculinity that has been shamed/robbed by feminist modernity (Taylor & Jackson, 2018)
- Men have to look out for own interests if society will not: manosphere creates danger and extracts social/financial resources to aide members protection racket (Bujalka et al., 2022)
- Fascism idealises bodily control as an alternative to degeneracy: e.g., Proud Boys' #NoWanks: pathway to extremism (Johannsen, 2021)


A hierarchy of men

If you're the kind of man you're supposed to be, you would have no time for that, and you wouldn't need it. (Andrew Tate on PMO cycle)


You need to make the decision today that you're gonna stop being a little bitch. (NoFap content creator, Hartmann, 2021)

- Operationalisation of competitive masculinity.

 Manosphere taxonomies: tiered natural order of beta to alpha males (Han & Yin, 2022)
- Rebooters = real autonomous and self-regulatory men vs incel emotionality (Hartmann, 2021)
- NoFap masculinity: authentic and aspirational men must ignore misandrist expectations to be who they *really* are (Taylor & Jackson, 2018)
- Consumption = microcosm of manliness.
 Evidenced via stoic endurance, e.g., lockdown separated men from boys (Smith et al., 2022)
- Streak = meritocratic measure of manhood: failure can lead to self-loathing, depression and suicidality (Prause & Binnie, 2023)
- Share emotions over setbacks while striving for masculinities antithetical to vulnerable displays (Smith et al., 2022)

Neoliberal sexuality

This is where the "superpowers" come in: confidence, motivation, the burning desire to leave your mark. All of these benefits stem from your brain giving you the highest chance to reproduce (NoFap content creator, Hartmann, 2021)

You'll be a different person, and others will notice how much better you've got through NoFap (r/NoFap user, Smith et al., 2022)

- Instrumentalisation of women: rewards vs decision-makers - meritocratic heterosexuality (Hartmann, 2021): interest = man's erotic capital
- Manosphere/NoFap idealise self-expressing, entrepreneurial, risk-bearing, masculinities to compete for finite resources: women's attention (Bratich & Banet-Weiser, 2019)
- Most men: lazy, demasculinized masturbators vs sovereign/attractive 1% (Smith et al., 2022)
- Totalising meritocracy: increases dominance and mastery elsewhere, e.g., industry (Burnett, 2021)
- Abstinence success = capitalist success: products unlock "Elon Musk" mindset via focus, e.g., Mr Mind Blowing; Self-Conquering sites
- Trademarked organisations/products vs grassroots variable: r/PornFree < strict/violent than r/NoFap (Chasioti & Binnie, 2021; Prause & Ley, 2024)
- Incentive variance: perception of addiction, relationship issues, fun, challenge, erectile dysfunction myths (Fernandez et al., 2021; Imhoff & Zimmer, 2020)
 - Diverse userbase: e.g., Religion (Burnett, 2021): Indian culture: semen as lifeforce, Chinese *Jiese* (abstinence) as tradition/resistance to capitalism
 - > Does uncritically aligning NoFap with the manosphere promote/normalise Western-centric sexualities? (Smith et al., 2022)

General discussion: Masters of their domain?

- Presence/perseverance of misogynistic beliefs at communal level should concern reboot websites/content creators
- Strengthening male hegemony/dehumanising women/reconnecting with innate male power manosphere tenets on reboot sites
- Despite implications of medicalizing/stigmatizing high pornography use, sociopolitical prescriptions less obvert than other manosphere subjectivities
- Pipeline in/out of inceldom: facilitate exit or reaffirm inferiority? Interconnectedness is missed by manosphere vs non-manosphere dichotomy (Burnett, 2021)
